Tigers air out record book

It was definitely a feel-good season for the NBC football team as 2018 saw the Tigers post their first winning record and playoff qualification in 10 years.

Along the way, the Tigers' high-flying offense rewrote the school record book, especially when it came to throwing the football, which they did at a pace never before seen. The Tigers threw about 50 percent more passes this season than any previous year. Before quarterback Austin Endorf arrived on the scene, the school record for completions in a game was 18. This season Endorf averaged 20.7 completions per game.

Endorf now holds all the school passing records except for one: Jake Wesch's 90 percent completion percentage in a single game.

Even with another year left to play, Endorf emerges from his junior season as the NBC career leader in passing yards. In his two years as a starter, he's thrown for 4,163 yards. The previous record was 3,625 by four-year starter Andrew Minarick.

Endorf also set a pair of state records this season, with his 497 passing yards in the opener, a state Class C2 record. In that same game

he set a school record with six touchdown passes. He would bookend that with another six touchdown passes in the playoff game against Wilber-Clatonia, which set a new 11-man playoff state record. Endorf's 29 touchdown passes this season nearly doubled the previous record of 16 by Mike Albert. Endorf's 382 passing yards against Wilber-Clatonia fell three yards short of the C2 playoff record.

Senior wideout John Emanuel was on the other end of many of Endorf's passes. The previous career record for catches was 81 by Drew Hines. Emanuel had 78 catches this season alone. He also had the school's first 1,000-yard receiving season and ends his career with 107 catches for 1,421 yards, both records.

Emanuel's nine receiving touchdowns fell one short of Ethan Bauer's single season record.

Overall, the Tiger offense racked up a record 3,954 yards this season. However, the 395.4 yards per game falls just shy of the 396.6 yards per game by the 1996 team in its eight-game season.
